MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING Of the City of Northfield Council June 24, 2024

The regular meeting of the City of Northfield Council was held on Tuesday June 24, 2024 via Zoom.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Randolph Chappell.

MINUTES: Minutes for the May 2024 meeting were approved.

CITY ADMINISTRATION REPORTS

TREASURER'S REPORT

The Treasurer distributed financial reports prior to the meeting for activity ending May 31, 2024. They included:

- 2. Telecom Tax, Charlie reported that \$8120 represents twelve months.
- 3. Charlie moved snow removal to the road fund.
- 4. There are three unpaid residents tax bills totaling \$2600.

CITY CLERK

- Received a thank you note from the Chappell's for flowers.
- Memorial for the Lime Ridge site, in progress. Expecting a quote from Joy Monument this week. Two ideas proposed.

- Investigating online payment for tax bills. John Singler referred me to City of Middletown and City of Hurstbourne who have both used online payment for several years. I have contacts for each, and have reached out to both. I will report back with history, results and cost.
- Lucy will post the public meeting for budget review on the web site, July 22 at 7:15.

POLICE REPORT

June

- Northfield calls from neighbors most were concerns regarding traffic on U S 42 lane closures and power outages.
- 9 calls for service transferred over from LMPD

- 1 Theft report from Walgreens (\$500.00 of bath soap)
- 1 Check Fraud report resident (Holiday Manor post box, USPS is surveilling the area)

- Ofc Hile assisted a senior citizen at Walgreens preventing a fraud attempt against his accounts
- 4 street lights were reported out to LG&E
- Metro works was contacted to remove a deer from the sidewalk on U S 42
- MSD has been contacted several times to pick up the steel plate on Wynnewood but so far no results.

CITY ENGINEER'S REPORT

- Repaying completed: Baylor Dr., Fox Creek Ct., Jeness Ct, Northfield Ct., Rhodes Ct., Rhodes Drive. Striping completed with a caveat. Sharon reported that Northfield/Stannye still needs to be completed. As a result of the repaying, the contractor will:
 - Replace two mailboxes resolved
 - Repair multiple driveway aprons resolved
- Crack sealing in progress: Baylor Ct., Keewood Ct., New Market Dr., Northfield Dr., Stannye Dr.
- Sidewalk repair. In progress.
- City street and stop signs to be painted and straightened. In progress.

OLD BUSINESS

• In Progress: Lime Ridge Sidewalk, continuing to work with Dr. Raja on documentation and design of sidewalk landscaping.

- In progress: NF Main Entrance signage update (Tracy).
- In Progress: Flock Security cameras: 5 are in place, 4 other locations are being assessed. The cameras are \$650 each to install and then there is a recurring cost of \$3K each per year. A Municipal Order (#2) was approved.

NEW BUSINESS

- Digital signs: The Mayor presented the signs and their features. Pros and cons were discussed. More research on the signs is required.
- Fence down along US42. City attorney has confirmed that Northfield may replace the fence.
 - Tracy has the completed survey of the affected area to determine property line.
 - Tracy will get some cost estimates (\$75K placeholder until firm estimate received).
 - A permit will be required to proceed further.
 - Fence design to be determined after a decision is made to replace/repair parts of the fence, or to rebuild the entire fence.
- In progress: Could Northfield sponsor a citywide leaf pickup, Tracy is attempting to identify a vendor, further discussion at that point. (\$20K placeholder until firm estimate received).
- Budget for 2024-2025 Fiscal year
 - The Mayor reviewed the 2024 budget
 - Ordinances required: A public hearing will be conducted on July 22 at 7:15. This has been posted to the Northfield website.
 - Approved/passed: 24.01 Amends budget to cover the cost of the new police car (amends 2023-2024 budget)
 - Approved/passed: 24.02 New Budget
 - Approved/passed: 24.03 Ad Valorem Tax Rate .142

PARKING LOT

- NF Elected and Appointed Official pay evaluation for FY24
- Speed Hump Policy: Second Reading on hold pending Traffic Engineer input, and final report. Randy has contacted two engineers.
- Ky Transportation Coop Signup
- Small Cellular Site Ordinance: Distributed for review to all council members. Discussion scheduled tabled for a future meeting.
