City of Northfield Ordinance No. 25-03

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE REGULAR MEETING TIME AND PLACE OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the City of Northfield finds that its ordinance establishing the regular time and place of its City Council meeting should be updated to comply with the revisions to Kentucky Revised Statutes allowing meetings to be held via video teleconference,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: Any ordinance establishing the time and place of the regular meeting of the City of Northfield City Council is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: The regular meeting of the City of Northfield City Council is hereby set for 6 p.m. on the 1st Monday of each month, provided however, in the event the said day should fall on a legal holiday as defined in KRS 2.110, said meeting shall be held on the next succeeding day that is not a legal holiday. The regular meeting will be held via video teleconference. Specific notice on how any member of the public or media organization may view the meeting electronically shall be provided on the City's website not later than 24 hours in advance of the meeting. The city need not provide a physical viewing location where the public may see and hear all the members of a video teleconference meeting, unless two of more members are attending from the same physical location. If the meeting is also in-person, the place of the regular meeting shall be held at the following physical location: 5900 Hunting Road, Louisville, Kentucky.

The regular meeting schedule and public access requirements herein are to be held in accordance with KRS 61.826.

SECTION 2:

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval, according to law.
